Inventory of The John Sawhill Collection of Ancient Coins Held by The James Madison Foundation

The Collection:

The collection is comprised of 199 Greek coins and 217 Roman coins; the total number of items in the collection is 416.

The Inventory:

The inventory is arranged in accordance with accepted practices regarding the classification of numismatic items. For purposes of identification each coin is described fully with appropriate references. Greek coins are enumerated with the letter **G + #**. Roman coins are enumerated with the letter **R + #**. For purposes of record each coin has been photographed. The organization of this record follows the arrangement of the collection inventory.

Exceptions: 1. There is no division in the inventory for Greek Imperial] Roman Colonial coins because there are so few coins that would fit this category - these coins are listed in the Roman section under the appropriate emperor. 2. Coins listed without a reference indicates that a specific secondary identification could not be found.

Grading: The following are the abbreviations, accepted by numismatists in the U.S. and the U.K., for the grading of ancient coins and used in this inventory :

- G** Good (*considerable wear; legend barely legible*)
- VG** Very Good (*evident wear; legend somewhat legible*)
- F** Fine (*some wear; legend legible*)
- VF** Very Fine (*traces of wear; legend clear*)
- EF** Extremely Fine (*no traces of wear*)
- +/-** Higher or lower level within a grade
- Ex. **VF - EF** Coin ranges within two grades
- Ex. **VF/EF** Obverse is VF/Reverse is EF
